

BRIEFING OF SHENMUE

The vibrant scene of 1986 Yokosuka comes to life.

The game was released on the Sega Dreamcast in 1999 and reproduced the world as if it actually existed, offering unprecedented player freedom. Shenmue greatly influenced many other works and was regarded as a legendary action-adventure game for creating an alternate reality through its 3D open-world. It incorporated motion capture to create realistic character movement, fully voiced every character including side characters roaming the streets, and used polygon rendering for all the cityscapes, characters, and event scenes. Shenmue also featured changing weather conditions and day-night cycles. It even had characters go about their own routines. The combination of all these features created a fully immersive player experience and pioneered the 3D open-world video game genre. In 2018, the game was rereleased on the PS4® and Steam® with various refinements such as improved graphics, better controls, and enhanced UI. Experience and enjoy the vibrant scene of 1986 Yokosuka.

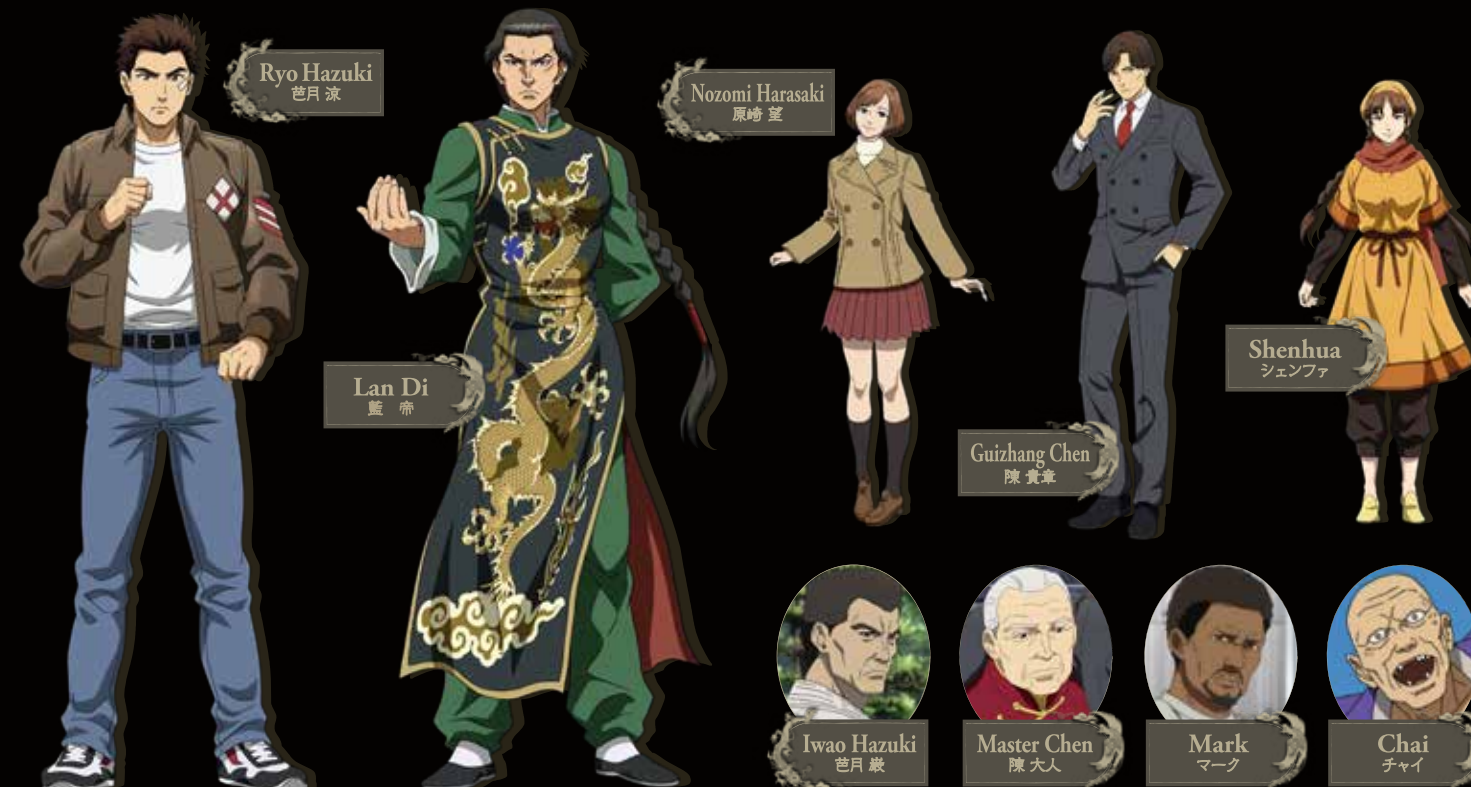
SHENMUE THE ANIMATION

As a sports center for the Yokosuka-Mura area, it is the site of regional sport competitions. The Kanagawa Karate Tournament and Kanagawa Prefectural qualifying rounds are held here, just like in the anime.</p> | <p>SHENMUE THE ANIMATION Dobuita Street YOKOSUKA Dobuita Street</p> <p>Although most of the stores that still bear the look of the postwar entertainment district are gone, there are several stores on Dobuita Street that were operating in 1986, the year Shenmue was set. The animated series depicts these stores more true to life than the game does, so please visit them to see for yourself.</p> | <p>SHENMUE THE ANIMATION KNOCKING YOKOSUKA KNOCK MOTOR</p> <p>Founded in 1958, KNOCK MOTOR operated on Dobuita Street from 1982 to 2006. At that time, they also had a shop on the U.S. military base. As a pioneer in customizing choppers, KNOCK MOTOR is famous not only among Japanese motorcycle enthusiasts but also among Americans living in Japan. The reproduction in the anime of the shop on Dobuita Street is almost perfect.</p> |
| <p>SHENMUE THE ANIMATION Mikasa Park YOKOSUKA Mikasa Park</p> <p>Mikasa Park features the Mikasa, the flagship of the Russo-Japanese War and one of the world's "Three Great Memorial Ships." You can also see Monkey Island and ships crossing through Tokyo Bay. The anime features the Mikasa at night. *Please note that Mikasa Park closes at 9pm (and closes at 6pm from Nov-March).</p> | <p>SHENMUE THE ANIMATION Dobuita St - New Yokosuka Harbor Warehouses YOKOSUKA Route 16</p> <p>From the scene when Ryo takes Harasaki on a motorcycle ride after rescuing her from her kidnappers. In the animated version, she understands his fierce determination and sends him off. Route 16 is a series of tunnels, so the scene alternates between darkness and light, representing her wavering emotions.</p> | <p>SHENMUE THE ANIMATION Suka High YOKOSUKA Yokosuka High School</p> <p>Yokosuka High School was established in 1908 as a secondary school under the old education system. Pledging to uphold "autonomy and independence" as well as "both academics and athletics," it is a prestigious school that has produced a Nobel laureate, a Person of Cultural Merit, an Olympic gold medalist, and a Prime Minister of Japan. Construction of the current school building began in 1959 and has remained unchanged since 1986, the year Shenmue takes place.</p> |

New Yokosuka Port Warehouses (Nagaura Port)
 In order to collect information on the Mad Angels, Ryo sneaks in to their hideout through his part-time job. He sets out to Hong Kong from this location.
 ※Warehouse entry is prohibited except for authorized personnel, but you can see the warehouses from a distance around the former crane site.

Route 16
 In order to save the kidnapped Nozomi, Ryo speeds on this road to get to the warehouses.
 ※You can see the view of the tunnels that connect Yokosuka.
 Warning!! You cannot arrive at the warehouses from Dobuita within two minutes.

Dobuita Street
 This is the area where Ryo gathered information about his father's killer. Many people live around this bustling street lined with stores.
 ※The atmosphere of present-day Dobuita Street has changed since 1986, but you can still feel that familiar vibe from the remaining stores and see traces of the past scattered throughout the area.

Sakuragaoka (Midorigaoka) ~ Yamanose
 Yamanose is the in-game residential area connected to Dobuita and represents Sakuragaoka, Yamanose Shrine, and the Hazuki Residence.

| SHENMUE YOKOSUKA Aida Florist Hanamatsu Established in 1933, this flower shop is located in Yokosuka-chuo. True to the game, you can find this shop off the corner of the Ryocho Temple. Its location is similar to how the Aida Flower Shop can be found around the corner as you descend from Sakuragaoka into Dobuita. MAP 1 | SHENMUE YOKOSUKA Kurita Military Surplus Kakita This military shop has undergone little change since its establishment in the post-war era. It is said to be the best in-game recreation of a real location. The shop is filled with surplus U.S. Military goods and they can make you your own personal dog tag within five minutes. It is their most popular and recommended souvenirs. MAP 3 | SHENMUE YOKOSUKA Mary's Patches & Embroidery Taisho Mishin Shishuten Established in 1951, this store specializes in sukajans and hand sewn patches. The inside of the store is packed with hand sewn goods. They will take custom orders, but be aware that the owner is elderly so their hours of operation are short and they are closed Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and rainy days. They may take sudden leaves of absence, so call and check for their availability beforehand. TEL: 046-823-3130 MAP 5 | SHENMUE YOKOSUKA Honcho 1-chome Bus stop Honcho 1-chome Bus stop You can find the bus stop that Ryo used to commute to the New Yokosuka Harbor District for his part-time job. Just like Ryo, you too can take this bus to Nagaura Port. Ride the Keikyu Bus Hachi 31 Route round for Uchikawabashi and get off at Tanoura or Hokubu Kyosai Hospital. MAP 7 |
| SHENMUE YOKOSUKA Suzume Park Odakicho Park You can find this small park near the stairway from Dobuita Street to Midorigaoka. In-game, between Dobuita and Sakuragaoka, there is a similar park where you can find the elderly often resting on the benches. Both parks share the same location at the foot of the stairs leading uphill and are found near the entrance of Dobuita. MAP 2 | SHENMUE YOKOSUKA Water Dragon vol.2 MIKASA vol.2 This shop was established in 1952 and originally sold sukajan souvenirs targeted towards U.S. military personnel. Even today, you can find many sukajans on display. The original in-game model for Jupiter's Jackets, which also sold sukajans, was a store named Jupiter that unfortunately closed down in 2015. MAP 4 | SHENMUE YOKOSUKA Funny Bear BURGER Honey Bee Established in 1968, this authentic American diner is located in front of the Main Gate of the U.S. Naval Base and is popular among the stationed Americans. This diner is certified to sell the famous Yokosuka Navy Burger. In-game, you can find this location towards the back of Dobuita. MAP 6 | SHENMUE YOKOSUKA KNOCKING KNOCK MOTOR There used to also be a shop down the road by Honey Bee, but now KNOCK MOTOR only operates in Kinugasa Sakae-cho. It is beloved as a pioneer of chopper customization. The owner himself drew the store's sign that appears in both the video game and anime. MAP 9 |

SAKURAGAOKA YAMANOSE

While it is difficult to pinpoint and introduce a specific part of the Sakuragaoka ~ Yamanose residential area, there are many streets and shrines similar to in-game locations around Dobuita Street still remaining in the present. As you walk around town and ponder thoughts about the game, you may find some unexpected locations that will bring back familiar memories. Odakicho Park is especially steeped in Yamanose ambiance.

YAMANOSE SHRINE
Suwadai Shrine
 The shrine was established in 1380 and designated as a place of worship for gods of agriculture and fishing in 1606. It is represented in-game as the Yamanose Shrine, the location where you can take care of the orphaned kitten. The view of the shrine as you climb uphill is especially memorable.

NEW YOKOSUKA HARBOR WAREHOUSES ROUTE 16

See the warehouses where Ryo worked part-time while collecting information on the Mad Angels. The crane you could view in-game was taken down in 2013 due to aging and only the scaffoldings remain. You can also see the Nagaura Warehouses from a distance. Take the Keikyu Bus Hachi 31 Route and get off at Hokubu Kyosai Hospital. The observation site is located five minutes away by foot.

 In order to rescue the kidnapped Nozomi, Ryo speeds down this road on a motorcycle and then returns home with her by his side. You can see the view of the many tunnels that connect Yokosuka. The Keikyu Bus Hachi 31 Route from Honcho 1-chome to Tanoura travels along this road. In order to get to the Nagaura Warehouses, you must get off at Tanoura, turn right at the Anjinzuka Station intersection, and then walk 15 minutes to arrive at the location.
